22/06/21

Trull – Reports of suspected drink driver. No vehicle details.

23/06/21

Trull- Issue with an abusive delivery driver

Trull –Intimidation connected to an online offer to purchase a car (civil issue)

25/06/21

Honiton Road – vehicle obstructing the highway

28/06/21

Trull – Abandoned 999 call (accidental call)

29/06/21

Trull Road – Erratic driving

30/06/21

Trull-Vehicle defect (lights)/driving offences

02/07/21

M5 Over Bridge Cutsey -Concern for welfare (AIO call with good intent)

07/07/21

Trull- Indecent images shared on line by young persons.

08/07/21

Trull – Domestic assault (suspect arrested)

12/07/21

Trull- confused male calling 999 asking for Police but a medical concern.

13/07/21

Trull Road (near Queens College) – Male and female verbal argument. Possible residents of Canonsgrove.

Trull – Indecent images circulated.

17/07/21

Trull – accidental 999 call.

There have been 12 further calls directly to Canonsgrove during the reporting period, made by staff and residents on site.

Specific details cannot be shared but the general nature of these calls have been concerns for welfare, mental health crisis, drug related, non residents on site and ASB.

Patrols

The Neighbourhood Policing Team continue to carry out regular, high visibility patrols in Trull, Staplehay and Comeytrove on foot, by car and bike including regular visits to local businesses. All patrols are recorded on our patrol plans for reference and there are regular social media updates.

Partnership working

We continue to have weekly meetings with YMCA and SW&T to discuss any ongoing issues and concerns and maintain an up to date list of residents at Canonsgrove, as well as having a direct link to the team to discuss other incidents as they arise.

Lisa Rigby has started a Neighbourhood Engagement surgery on site (every two weeks) to engage with residents, deal with any issues and to give appropriate words of advice to those who are reported to be involved in causing ASB.

Plans are in place for a joint patrol of the village in company with Canonsgrove Manager for YMCA – Pat Collins.
