### ComeyTrull Urban

#### Extension

Trull Parish Council have opposed the application for approval of reserved matters following Outline Application 42/14/0069.

The application does not conform to the principles of Garden Town Planning, which is required following the government grant to the District Council for Garden Town status. Other matters considered in this response are; the lack of renewable energy planning and the inadequate consultation with local residents.
