A358 Consultation

Highways England will be undertaking a supplementary public consultation on the proposed A358 Taunton to Southfields Dualling Scheme. The move follows a joint effort from several parishes affected by the proposal, objecting to the consultation process and asking for it to be started again with a choice of routes. Trull Parish Council responded to Highways England with concerns about the original proposal which included a new motorway junction at Killams Avenue. The Council was concerned about the impact on the Vivary Green Wedge and the possibility of rat-running through the parish if the junction is ever opened for wider use. It also gave its support to the joint campaign led by Stoke St Mary Parish Council. The result has been an announcement that more work is needed to find the right solution for section 1 from the M5 to a proposed junction (junction B) in the vicinity of West Hatch Lane. Highways England said: "We have listened to the feedback received, and realise that more work is needed to find the right solution for section 1. We understand that there has been some frustration that only one option for section 1 was taken to consultation and we are addressing this by holding a supplementary consultation with more options. The detail of these options will be made available when we officially launch the consultation. The supplementary consultation will be launched and completed this calendar year and will be supported by a series of public exhibitions."

Trull Parish Council has considered the annual inspection report for play equipment on the KGV field and made a number of recommendations. The Twingly has been repaired. The installation of a new play fort has been completed and delivery taken of a new rocker and dish roundabout which are currently awaiting installation.

Car Park Repairs

Trull Parish Council agreed to make a payment towards the cost of repairs in the car park in Church Road. The work was carried out at the start of the schools summer break and included painting of the speed hump to make it more readily visible to pedestrians.

Police Report

From 19th June to 17th July seven calls were received – road related – 4, theft -1, robbery – 1, concern for welfare – 1. One crime was recorded – robbery -1. Speed watch patrols were held at Bradbeers between 2 and 3pm on 30th June, and 8 and 9am on 13th July. No data is available yet.
