# **Speeding at Gatchells**

Data from the Speed Indictor Device at Gatchell Oaks from 25 September to 9 October showed that 25,156 vehicles passed - an average of 1,797 a day. Of these 38% did less than 30 mph. which means that 62% exceeded the speed-limit. The data showed that 60% did 30-40 mph, 2% did 40-50 mph. and 18 vehicles (one or two each day) exceeded 50 mph.

# Helicopter landing
