A358 consultation

Highways England will consult again on the whole route of the A358 scheme rather than just the West Hatch to M5 section. The public and stakeholders will have the opportunity of a fuller say and there will be a number of options for consideration. Consultation dates and details are currently being finalised and will be announced in due course but HE will avoid consulting during December and over the Christmas / New Year period. Speeding at Gatchells

Data from the Speed Indicator Device at Gatchell Oaks from 25 September to 9 October showed that 25,156 vehicles passed - an average of 1,797 a day. Of these 38% did less than 30 mph. which means that 62% exceeded the speed-limit. The data showed that 60% did 30-40 mph, 2% did 40-50 mph. and 18 vehicles (one or two each day) exceeded 50 mph.

Helicopter landing

Trull Parish Council has given permission for a helicopter to land on the KGV playing field on December 18, weather permitting.
