## **Patrols**

**The Neighbourhood Policing Team continue to carry out regular, high visibility patrols in Trull, Staplehay and Comeytrove on foot, by car and bike including regular visits to local businesses. Patrols are recorded on our patrol plans for reference and there are regular social media updates.**

**PCSO Lyndsay has restarted her regular Neighbourhood Engagement surgeries at The Hive Café.**

## **Partnership working**

**We continue to have weekly meetings with YMCA and SW&T to discuss any ongoing issues and concerns and maintain an up to date list of residents at Canonsgrove, as well as having a direct link to the team to discuss other incidents as they arise.**

**Joint patrols/annual rough sleeper count conducted by Rough Sleeper Team in company with Police and volunteers between 12-02.30 hours on Thursday 18 November.**

**Lisa and Marshall hold a Neighbourhood Engagement surgery on site at Canonsgrove (every two weeks) to engage with residents, deal with any issues and to give appropriate words of advice as necessary.**

**Lyndsay continues to hold Neighbourhood Engagement Surgeries at The Hive Café.**

**Bike lights have been delivered to Canonsgrove and there has been a noted improvement in residents' safety on the roads.**
