A358 consultation

Highways England are running their new consultation on the proposal to upgrade the A358 between the M5 at Taunton and the Southfields Roundabout joining the A303. There are now three options for the section between the M5 and West Hatch. The consultation began on 16th January and will run for 6 weeks until 27th February. Public consultation exhibition events are taking place where members of the HE team will be on hand to explain the proposals. Once the consultation is completed all responses will be analysed and presented in a consultation report, which will be published when HE make their Preferred Route Announcement in late 2018. There will then be a statutory public consultation on the proposal before they submit the application for a Development Consent Order which is needed for a Nationally Significant Infrastructure project.

SID Programme

Somerset County Council will not be providing a community speed indicator device (SID) service to Parish and Town Councils from the 31st March. The council's current stock of SIDs is reaching the end of its serviceable life and a large investment would be required to replace it which the present financial position of the SCC does not allow for. Trull Parish Council currently has SIDs at Bradbeers and Gatchells for two weeks each twice a year. It has expressed an interest in the possible provision of SIDs for Parish/Town Councils who are willing to make a regular financial

contribution towards the installation costs. The decision will be dependent on detailed costs when they are available.

Police Report

Six calls were received since 18th December: - 2 suspicious incidents, 1 theft, 2 road related incidents, 1 concern for welfare. There were two crimes recorded: - 1 theft of bicycles from an open area, 1 assault– dog bite on human. A Beat Surgery will be held in the Trull Church Community Centre between - 2.30-3.30 on -9th February. There have been no Speedwatch patrols during this period. Anyone who witnesses an incident is reminded to report it on 101 or 999 as appropriate to the circumstances.

Budget Set
