Trull Meadow Meeting

The land at Trull Meadow has now been advertised for sale at a cost of £175,000. There is to be an Open Meeting at 6pm in the School Hall on Friday 4th October to outline the current situation and give you the opportunity to express your views. This will be followed by an Extraordinary Parish Council meeting to allow the Parish Council to consider the views expressed by parishioners and vote on whether to take action. Please do come

Comeytrove/Trull Urban Extension

Mr A Kent reported that the S106 agreement has now been signed; None of the plans submitted with S106 reflect any of the concerns the Parish Council have raised about the impact of the roundabout on the character of Trull, the demolition of historic walls, the lack of adequate flood protection and the impact on traffic flow through the village.. Neither is there any detail of the intersection of the Spine Road with the Dipford Road, an undertaking that contractor's traffic will not be using the Honiton and Dipford Roads for access to the site
