A358 Consultation

Highways England intends to give exhibitions and presentations at various parishes affected by the proposed A358 Taunton to Southfields Dualling Scheme as part of the supplementary public consultation. Trull Parish Council has asked if the parish can be included as one of the proposed venues. It submitted concerns about the original proposal to create a new motorway junction at Killams Avenue, the impact on the Vivary Green Wedge and the possibility of rat-running through the parish if the junction is ever opened for wider use. It also gave its support to the joint campaign led by Stoke St Mary Parish Council.

Trull Parish Council has agreed in principle to fund the cost of two dropdown signs to warn people of flooding when it occurs on Dipford Road. It was hoped that the Council could be responsible for

operation of the signs but it has been advised that this would need to be carried out by the police or Somerset County Council highway service provider.

SID Report

Data from the Speed Indicator Device at Bradbeers for July 10th - 24th shows the average number of vehicles passing per day was 1028. Of these 93.9% exceeded the 30mph limit; 35.6% exceeded 40mph and 2.7% (28 vehicles a day) exceeded 50mph.

The Parish Council has successfully applied for Somerset County Council to install a series of road markings and warning signs at this location in a bid to reduce traffic speeds.

Road Closure

Furlong Green will be closed for two days from the junction with Honiton Road to enable Somerset Highways to carry out resurfacing works. The order becomes effective on 17th October 2017 and the works are expected to last for two days. An alternative route will be sign posted while the closure is in operation.
