Multiple calls are being made to police regarding a resident from Canonsgrove's behaviour / ASB in the community. The person in question is also suffering with Mental Health and making multiple 999 calls to police on a daily basis.

Police are taking positive action are in the process of working with YMCA to come to an outcome together regarding the resident.

We welcome reports from members of the public and Trull Community for the person in question causing issues so that positive action can be taken.

We understand as a local policing team that the effect of the persons behaviour is having an effect on the wider community.

Patrols *********

The Neighbourhood Policing Team continue to carry out regular, high visibility patrols in Trull, Staplehay and Comeytrove on foot, by car and bike including regular visits to local businesses. Patrols are recorded on our patrol plans for reference and there are regular social media updates.

Partnership working *********

We continue to have weekly meetings with YMCA and SW&T to discuss any ongoing issues and concerns and maintain an up to date list of residents at Canonsgrove, as well as having a direct link to the team to discuss other incidents as they arise.

Lyndsay continues to hold regular Neighbourhood Engagement Surgeries at The Hive Café.

A beat surgery can be set up at The Hive Café or other chosen place in between Lyndsays should it be required. Please let me know if this is wanted by residents.
