The following incidents have been reported during the period of

01/04/2022 – 30/04/2022

01/04/2022 – Trull - Domestic Incident

- Trull – Abandoned 999 Call

02/04/2022 – Trull – Anti-Social Behaviour, reports of a loud party at an adjoining property. (Several calls from different neighbours regarding this)

05/04/2022 – Trull – ASB, Reports of Ukraine fundraiser posters being removed by war crime propaganda, police have investigated and are dealing locally with appropriate means along with increased patrols in the area.

06/04/2022 – Trull – Sexual offences, isolated domestic incident. No cause for concern to other residents.

09/04/2022 – Trull – Assault

- Trull – ASB, Drunk males from Canonsgrove causing a nuisance in the area. Returned back to CG safe and well.

10/04/2022 – Trull – Suspicious males attending home addresses threatening to beat up neighbours. Officers patrolled area and stop searched 2 males. Appropriate checks conducted.

11/04/2022 – Trull – Domestic Incident

12/04/2022 – Trull - Abandoned 999 Call

- Trull – Neighbour Dispute

14/04/2022 – Trull – Concern for welfare – Intoxicated male fallen over by Queens College, taken back to residency.

16/04/2022 – Trull – Concern for welfare

26/04/2022 – Trull – Abandoned 999 Call

All calls above were not related to persons from Canonsgrove unless stated otherwise.

There have been 3 further calls connected to Canonsgrove during the reporting period

There have been some ongoing parking tension around Sweethay Close with vehicles parking on the corner of the close, causing obstruction to the road and pavement. Warning letters have been placed onto the vehicles and we hope this will encourage other residents to stop parking there.

We must remind residents that obstructing the pavement and road is a criminal offence as well as causing inconvenience to members of the public and other residents in the area.

Patrols

The Neighbourhood Policing Team continue to carry out regular, high visibility patrols in Trull, Staplehay and Comeytrove on foot, by car and bike including regular visits to local businesses. Patrols are recorded on our patrol plans for reference and there are regular social media updates.

We are aware of more recent ASB in the bus shelter being reported, if persons are found in the bus shelter drinking then they will be moved away from the area. We encourage more calls to police to be able to take positive action and intervene.

Partnership working

We continue to have weekly meetings with YMCA and SW&T to discuss any ongoing issues and concerns and maintain an up to date list of residents at Canonsgrove, as well as having a direct link to the team to discuss other incidents as they arise.

Lyndsay continues to hold regular Neighbourhood Engagement Surgeries at The Hive Café.
