Trull Parish Council

TPO Working Group - Terms of Reference

Remit:

 The Working Group exists to assess trees within the village that may require a Tree Preservation Order.

Time:

- The Working Group shall be constituted for a period of two years.
- The initial period may be extended for an additional period which must be defined by the Parish Council in a full council meeting.

Composition:

- The Working Group must include at least two members from Trull Parish Council.
- The Working Group may comprise community residents or individuals co-opted for their expertise.

Powers:

- The Working Group has no decision-making capabilities.
- The Working Group may only act under the direction of the Parish Council.
- The Working Group has no requirement to publish an agenda.
- The Working Group has no requirement to keep minutes.
- There is no requirement for the Clerk to attend the Working Group.
- All members of the Working Group must be familiar with its Terms of Reference.

Expenses:

 The Working Group has no budget. Reasonable incidental expenses incurred by the Working Group will be paid by the Parish Council subject to approval.

Data:

All information collected is to be available to the Parish Council.

Reporting:

- The Working Group may submit a short monthly report to the Parish Council.
- The Working Group may produce written proposals which could meet the stated use of the Village Field. These proposals must detail...
 - 1. What is involved,
 - 2. An assessment of risk,
 - 3. A timescale of the proposals,
 - 4. Who will be involved and how the project will be managed,
 - 5. If full or partial funding is required,
 - 6. How the community will benefit,
